APPLICATION INFORMATION

The MBAKS Professional Women in Building Council supports women choosing careers in the Washington housing industry by awarding qualified students an educational scholarship. Scholarship funds can be applied towards formal, Washington State accredited education programs offered by community colleges, state colleges, vocational colleges, or technical colleges. Scholarship funds may be applied towards tuition and required course materials. Individual scholarship awards are a minimum of \$1000.00.

REQUIREMENTS

Funds awarded will be paid directly to the program requested and may be used for tuition, books, or course-required supplies and equipment. Applications will be accepted from April 12, 2023–June 30, 2023. Recipients will be notified by July 31, 2023. You must complete all sections of this application. Type or print in black ink.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

Applicants must be pursuing a degree or training in a construction-related field at a Washington-based technical school, community college, or university, with preference to applicable programs at an MBAKS EP/Student Chapter institution.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Completed and signed application
- ✓ Current university or college transcript (if applicable)
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation. Letters can be from a teacher, counselor, work supervisor, employer, or other professional who can speak to your character, performance, contributions, and life goals.

AWARDS & FINE PRINT

Scholarships will be awarded at partial or full tuition per student per year. Applications will be reviewed, and recipients selected by Master Builders Association committee and/or the Professional Women in Building Council. Include a copy of the highest-level degree or diploma earned. For college students: unofficial transcript is accepted. Applicant's interest in residential construction industry, grades, employment experience, extracurricular activities, references, and financial need will be considered. Checks will be sent directly to the designated school on behalf of the scholarship recipient. Recipient is required to send a written acknowledgment of the scholarship award to the Master Builders Association within 30 days of notification or offer is null and void.

Recipients will be required to sign an agreement indicating they will be responsible for keeping the Master Builders Association up to date on address, phone number, email, and name of employer upon graduation. Recipient agrees to be recognized at an event sponsored by the awarding MBAKS program and agrees to have their story promoted by MBAKS unless extenuating circumstances exist. Master Builders Association will acknowledge receipt of application via email. Incomplete applications will not be considered. All information provided is considered confidential and will not be shared beyond committee review. Scholarships are awarded on an equal opportunity basis, without regard to national origin, gender, age, religion, ethnicity, disability, or veteran status.
